Atopic Dermatitis,



also known as eczema, is a condition characterized by a red, itchy rash on the skin which causes cracking and swelling. It is very common, affecting more than 18 million American adults. The cause for Atopic Dermatitis is currently unknown, but it may be linked to an overactive immune system.





Plaque Psoriasis

is an immune system disorder in which skin cells grow uncontrollably on the surface of the skin and build up causing "plagues." The most common places for plagues are on the knees, elbows, back and scalp. The most common symptoms are burning, stinging, itching and skin tightness.

High Cholesterol

is a buildup of fats (lipids and triglycerides) in the blood. High lipid levels can cause your arteries to harden. As more plaque builds up, your arteries can narrow and stiffen which can eventually lead to reduced blood flow through your arteries. This can increase your risk of heart disease, stroke and other vascular diseases.
