# Asthma is a chronic respiratory condition. It causes

inflammation of the air passages that result in a temporary narrowing of the airways that carry oxygen to the lungs. Some symptoms include coughing, wheezing, shortness of breath and chest tightness. This disease affects about 26 million Americans. Ignoring treatment can limit your ability to exercise and be active, but getting proper treatment can help you live well.

## Migraines are a common type of headache that are

characterized by an intense throbbing or pulsing in one area of the head and are commonly accompanied by nausea, vomiting, or extreme sensitivity to light and sound. For some sufferers, migraines are preceded or accompanied by auras, flashes of light or blind spots. Migraines typically last between 4 and 72 hours.
